So Mc Donough took him in and treated his wounds within days, his friend started to heal. Because of Army regulations, the puppy was hidden from the top brass. One day the puppy was in a Kevlar helmet. That's when he got his name K-Pot. Eventually the platoon was caught and the superiors ordered the dog to be put down. The soldiers made other plans, they found out about a program called Operation Baghdad Pups. It is run by the Society of the Preventions of Cruelty to Animals. They were able to get K-Pot to the United States, where he now lives in New Jersey.
