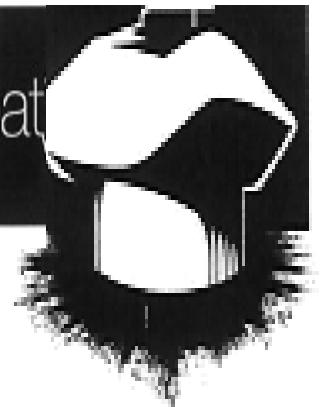
Busy season coming up, get involved and start having fun again like I do!

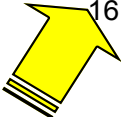
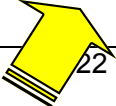
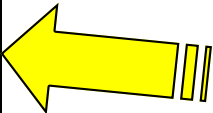
Each ticket is \$5 dollars or 3 for \$10
