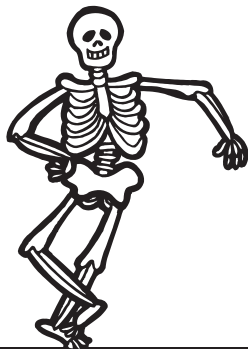

## MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Nobles,

At last night's Men's Night meeting (September 26), the board made a recommendation to the Nobility to transfer twenty five thousand dollars from our Morgan Stanley account to our General Fund. The recommendation was accepted with only one dissenting vote. There were 40+ Nobles in attendance and a fair amount of discussion ensued and the recommendation was accepted as noted.

The reason for this action is to pay off debts that we, the Ocala Shrine Club, have incurred over the past few years. At this point in time, the interest we are paying on outstanding debt outweighs the interest we are receiving from our savings. The board has for some time had to review our overall operations and, after a considerable amount of evaluation and decisions are prepared to make the necessary changes essential to make sound business decisions. We are well on our way to resolving the operating practices that put us into this situation with more to come.

As you all know the Ocala Shrine Club membership has decreased in the past 10 years. In the year 2000 we had around 600 members, today we have just over 200. With the decrease in membership brings a decrease in revenues. Not only from dues but also in our Wednesday and Friday night dinners and yes, even in the Red Fez lounge.

With the economy the way it is, we have also taken a big loss; almost all of the outside catering that we used to have is not what it used to be. This catering would bring in around \$100,000 per year and enabled us to do practically anything we needed or wanted to do at the club or in the community. The loss of revenue it has hurt us but will not defeat us! The Ocala Shrine Club Officers simply need to adjust how we do business and learn another way of supporting ourselves.

We have added another event for next year. We will be supplying food as we do for the rodeos but this time we have the opportunity to do the same for the Tractor Pulls this coming spring. This will take place in February and will bring in much needed money for the beginning of the year. Hopefully this will bring in \$16,000, which will fund the club for about two months or more with more changes.

One of the current issues we need to address is our Wed. and Fri. night dinners. The menu has been changed as you had asked. This has not yet improved the attendance we had all hoped for and need, although it has only been in effect for a couple months. So, do we change it again, or give it a chance for the Nobility to enjoy the change and support the Club?

We Officers need your input and assistance to help with YOUR club. It is not all gloom and doom, and your Officers are dedicated Brothers who have every interest of the Club at heart and will continue to take the appropriate action to keep the Ocala Shrine Club a place we will always be proud to be a member.

This was not a fun letter to have to write to you. Nonetheless, you need to know what is happening and why. If you have any questions or constructive comments, come see any of your officers at the club and share your concerns or suggestions.





